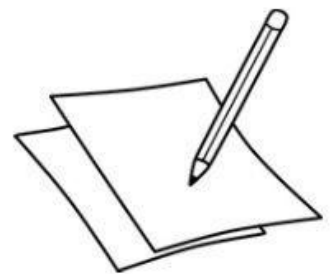

Let us name them and others in our hearts and present them and their needs before God's altar of grace; that their hearts, minds, bodies and spirits will find healing in Jesus.

- For those who are leaders of nations, that their Governments might be leavened with wise counsel and with those who know the faithfulness and rule of the everlasting God. Let us pray especially for our own government in another time of tumult; that wisdom, grace, and a true sense of service might prevail.

- This month's prayer requests from MAF (Mission Aviation Fellowship UK)

1. Pray for the worsening crisis in the Middle East.

Pray for those suffering because of the war in the Middle East: families grieving loss, people displaced, and communities living in fear. Ask God to protect the vulnerable and bring peace. Pray too for the knock-on impact on our mission, as fuel costs have surged (up 47% in Africa and 45% overall) and ask God to provide so life-saving flights can continue.

2. Pray for our Country Directors.

Ask the Lord to give our Country Directors wisdom, insight, and courage as they lead their teams through uncertainty. Pray for our overseas staff as they continue to work hard in getting our planes in the air despite this unprecedented time, and for the investment in our national staff.

3. Pray for our Mission Aviation Academy.

We urgently need more pilots and engineers. Training is costly, and yet essential if we are to raise up and equip the next generation of those who will serve overseas.
