#### **Letter from Lesley - FEEDING THE FIVE THOUSAND:**

As I walked through the hospital on Wednesday morning I spotted three Zebu (horned humped cattle) grazing contentedly in the open round where the helicopter lands on its rare visits. This was bad news for Zebu: by lunchtime, there was only one. This weekend the district conference of the Bible Baptist church of Madagascar takes place, and this year it is being hosted by the Mandritsara town churches of which



there are now three. There are three not because of growth and planting but as a result of satanic attack which three years ago removed the local pastor and split the congregation - for and against - in a hostile and bitter breakdown which threatened to disintegrate into tribal

feud. Out of the stump of this rotted tree of Jesse have grown up three 'green

shoots'. One of these 'new' churches has now its own building which is to be consecrated this Sunday.

600 people were pre-registered for this 4-day event but at least 1,000 are here with loads of children and youth.

They camp in an empty primary school (school holidays here too). Teaching, praise, youth and kids programme....like WRU conference.





And feeding? Each group brings their own rice, own tin plates. Everyone cooks. One Zebu feeds 200 people for 3 or 4 days feasting... so for 600, ..3 Zebu. On the next day the 3rd Zebu had also disappeared.

Think: out of spiritual disaster, three town churches and hundreds of believers coming from tiny village church plants, daughters of the original Baptist church. Tomorrow (Sunday) the new town church building- androvola - will be consecrated.

When Solomon's temple was consecrated, 22,000 oxen were killed. Fat burned on the altar but the people ate the meat. That's a feast for 4 million 400 thousand people.(4,400,000). Feeding a

lot more than 5 thousand - a whole nation dedicated to the Lord and fed by Solomon as his appointed representative.

Please pray for the dedication service Sunday 3rd August that all would be to God's glory and the disruptive forces still at work will be baffled and turned away.



Food banks in North West Leicestershire - would you believe there are two, maybe even three.

Coalville Foodbank - New Life Church - Margaret Street

"We don't think anyone in our community should have to face going hungry.
